After review of applications, selected candidates will be invited to the selection process scheduled for November, 2016 and including qualifying written exam, physical agility and skills tests. Applicants must ensure availability for both days. Pass/fail physical agility will require candidates to climb up to 75 feet, lift over 50 pounds and drag up to 185 pounds. Further selection steps will be released to candidates invited to the selection process, after review of the employment application and interest letter.
