SELECTION PROCESS

After review of certifications and experience, RRMFD will invite selected candidates to a qualifying language, writing, math skills test, modified-CPAT, fire skills test and oral board, as applicable. Physical agility and skills tests will require candidates to climb up to 75 feet, lift over 70 pounds and drag up to 185 pounds. Selected candidates will be invited to test the week of November 12th, 2018.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Lays and connects hose, holds nozzles and directs water streams, raises and climbs ladders and uses chemical extinguishers, bars, hooks, lines and other equipment at the scenes of fires; Performs salvage operations;
- Assess and Administer EMS to injured persons;
- Participates in fire drills and attends classes in firefighting, EMS and related duties;
- Performs inspections and general maintenance work to property and equipment;
- Inspects buildings and premises for compliance with fire laws, checks on complaints and aids in the investigation of arson cases;
- Attends public gatherings to ensure observance of fire safety requirements;
- Conducts tours of station houses for scout, civic and other interested groups;
- Operates, reviews and submits reports in electronic reporting system;
- Review all District Documentations for accuracy;
- Participates in physical fitness activities to maintain a "fit for duty status";
- Demonstrates continuous effort to improve operations, decrease turnaround times, streamline work processes, and work cooperatively and jointly to provide quality seamless customer service.
- Responds to emergency medical scenes, fire incidents, inter-facility transports, and other related emergency requests in a timely manner.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Knowledge of:

- Firefighting principles and practices and Emergency Medical techniques.
- Fire salvage and overhaul operations.
- Safe Emergency Vehicle Operations.

Skills in:

- Assessing and treating illness or injuries
- Applying CPR and first aid
- Performing fire suppression activities
- Operating hand & power tools
- Communication and interpersonal skills to interact with coworkers & public

Ability to:

- Work at heights greater than 75 feet.
- Move objects between 20-50 pounds short distances (20 feet or more).
- Understand and communicate, orally and in writing, in the English lang.
- Perceive red, yellow, and blue colors
- Tolerate extreme fluctuations in temperature while performing job duties.
- Work for long periods of time, requiring sustained physical activity & concentration.
- Rely on sense of sight and hearing.
